Contacto en Medios

- WHO: influenza AH1N1 cases rose to 763 in 18 countries, 61% are located in Mexico. Under consideration to take alert level to 6.
- WHO: 985 with A/H1N1 influenza in 20 countries.
- SS: before classe start again, parents and teachers will receive training
- The governors and President Felipe Calderón Hinojosa will meet to evaluate and and review the preventive measures with regards to the influenza contingency.
- The Government of Chiapas announced the suspension of classes and state public services until May 11th, except police and security activities.
- Concamin anticipates a loss of jobs between 670 and 730 thousand in the formal sector of the economy, and a 4,3 and 5,4% contraction.
- Mexico's air industry has cancelled 909 flights and reservations have fallen 35%.
